Just as important as deciding what to plant

....is understanding the soil preparations including fertilizing, soil pH, planting methods, seeding rates, depths and dates. Food plots also need follow up maintenance with fertilizers, grazing and pest management to be successful. See your local seed dealer and extension agent for specific guidelines in your area.

In order to attract wildlife you have to establish a diverse mix of habitat. Experts agree whether you choose annual or perennial plantings, it is better to have many well-distributed small plots than fewer large plots. Your plan should include safe havens and travel lanes in the form of trees and bushes for game to access all areas of your property. Good luck in all your wildlife experiences.
